Chicago, IL – Dr. Leonard Edloe was awarded the National Pharmaceutical Association (NPhA) Terrence Burroughs Pharmacy Leadership Award at the 62nd NPhA Annual Meeting. The Annual Meeting was held in Chicago, IL, July 17th – July 20th, 2009, at the Chicago Marriott Downtown Magnificent Mile.

The Terrence Burroughs Pharmacy Leadership Award recognizes contributions to the profession through involvement at both the local and national levels. Recipients of this award serve as a role model in volunteer community leadership positions and demonstrate a commitment to serving our community in various capacities.

Dr. Edloe serves as Chairman of the Quality, Safety, Risk and Credentials Committee of the Virginia Commonwealth University Health System Authority and a member of the board of Medicaid HMO, Virginia Premier. He also serves on the Board of the Virginia Pharmacists Foundation and also as Vice-Chair of the Richmond Memorial Health Foundation.

Dr. Edloe has given all of this to the community while leading his family owned pharmacy for the past 37 years, serving as the Pastor of the Antioch Baptist Church for the past 12 years, and serving as the host of a local talk show for the past year. He was elected the first black chairman of Retail Merchants and was honored by the local group as its Distinguished Retailer and Retailer of the Year by Virginia Retail Merchants Association.

Dr. Edloe is a graduate of the Howard University School of Pharmacy.
